

# Haiti Mission Trip – January 21 – 28, 2012

## Items to Collect:

- Chalk for chalk boards
- Artistic supplies for pre-k and kindergarten age
- Early elementary children's books in French (can be ordered on Amazon)
- Socks, underwear, t shirts (sizes 3-14)
- Sneakers
- Toys that all children can play with – jump ropes, basketballs, soccer balls, rubber playground balls
- Colorful hair ribbons for the girls
- Toothbrushes (children & adults) and toothpaste
- Personal hygiene items – soap, shampoo (small size), hand sanitizer, wash cloths, antibiotic cream, band aids, tissues (small packs), nail clippers, wide tooth comb
- Other medicines— aspirin, ibuprofen, chewable Tylenol, children's cold medicine-chewable tablets, and chewable vitamins for children (100 used each school day)
- Reading glasses
